MODEL XP-100 OWNER'S MANUAL

Our current XP-100 Owner's Manual states; "Trigger adjustment is factory sealed to provide correct weight of trigger pull." The parts list identifies part number (47) as Trigger Adjusting Screw which implies that it can be adjusted. See attached marked Owner's Manual.


It is suggested that we change the name from Trigger Adjusting Screw to Trigger Screw or Trigger Housing Screw Front. This would eliminate the possibility of gun owner attempting to adjust trigger weight.

This term is used in most of our Owner's Manuals which also should be changed.
