XP-100 PISTOL MODIFICATION FOR AUSTRALIA

This is in reply to your request of 9-24-79 for information as to whether we can modify the XP-100 Pistol as listed in the accompanying copy of the telegram to you from Australia.

1. A nut cannot be put on the Trigger Sear Block Stop Screw 17053. There is not enough clearance between the Screw and the Trigger Link for a nut. We presently use a red thread locking compound which is then coated with clear Duco cement. To use other means to lock the screw would require redesign of the parts.
2. The trigger pull on this pistol is fixed at  $1\frac{1}{2}$  to  $2\frac{3}{4}$  pounds. It would require redesign to meet the 4 pounds pull. It may require only a spring redesign but we would not be sure without investigation.
