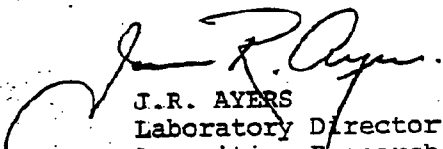

From the standpoint of consolidating the subject report, two minor areas of change in your reporting would be helpful. First, categorize the subjects according to the general headings of Research and Development, Status--Product Development, and Status--Process Development. It is difficult for me to determine the appropriate placement of each item. All items under Research and Development must be provided with a highlight; items under either Status section need no highlights. The second point is simply to save me time in correcting your copy. Use of capital letters on gun parts is not appropriate. For example, barrels should begin with a small "b".
