I'm in the process of targeting the .17 Cal., I am experiencing in the stainless steel barrels, excessive muzzle flash and a loud report. In going down range I am finding at about 70- to 90 yards. stripped jackets and pieces of bullets that have broken up. I am also getting key holes on the paper, and many of the shots do not even print on the target paper.

The ordnance steel has no problem of any kind and the groups are excellent after 1500 to 2000 rounds.
