SUBJECT: XP-100 FRONT SIGHT BASE WITH 2 ATTACHMENT HOLES

We have investigated the options available to fasten the front sight base to the receiver with two screws as per your request.

- Use present holes drilled in barrel and add another hole to the front of the sight base. (Sample supplied to you.)
- Add another hole to rear of sight base and add another hole to barrel.
- Add another hole to rear of sight base and make new front sight that extends to the rear to keep within the 15" radius required for Silhouette shooting.

We would recommend the first option.

At your convenience we would appreciate hearing from you on which option you prefer. If you would like to see more samples, please let us know.
