MONTHLY REPORT ITEMS-JANUARY 1990 FRED MARTIN

XP-100 WOOD STOCK
Marketing has decided that it would be desirable to have a wood stock on this production model. Bishop a commercial stock maker has been contacted for both a quotation and samples. The first sample was found to be too heavy for handgun silhouette competition. A second sample has been received and is beening evaluated. A formal test program will be outlined when the stock configuration is finalized. Other changes are barrel contour and trigger adjustment.

7mm Weatherby Magnum
The decision to offer this caliber in the M700 Classic was made by the product team last December. Ammunition will also be offered. Ilion has supplied Lonoke with two pressure and velocity barrels we will also provide them a sample rifle to complete their testing. Testing at Ilion may be slowed due the lack of ammo production. It is planned to transmit the drawing package by April 15. Final testing may have to be done along with trial and pilot testing.

6mm BR Rem
The product team has made the decision to add this caliber to the M700 varmint line. Testing to determine the correct twist for the barrel have been done with no satisfactory results. It is appears that the twist and factory loaded ammo are not compatitable. As a result of the planned additional ammo offerings more testing is planned. Six prototypes are to be fabricated by the custom shop, and will be available for testing by the end of February. Feeding, accuracy, function and abuse testing are planned.

Sniper Rifle
I have been providing technical support for the Sniper program. This has included drawing completion/changes and assistance on problems as they occure. At present there are two areas that I am working on:

Scopes-A problem with the adjustments on the day optical sight.

Trigger Assembly-Six guns have been returned some some with trigger related problems.
