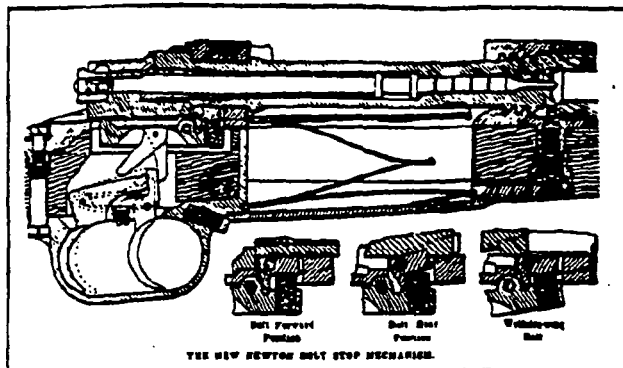




Original Newton self trigger patented Feb. 6, 1917 is well designed and very durable. The front or firing trigger operates the bolt stop. The trigger cannot pull the bolt stop down once it has risen, but holding it rearward prevents the stop from rising.

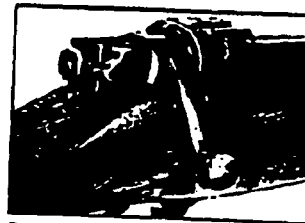


Ejector slot (arrow) is vertical in the boltface of original model serial no. 2772. In later rifle no. 2772 below it is rearward.
