The general condition of the gun appeared to be normal. It was noted that there were some slight marks on the stock, and the rear sight and scope screws had been removed. In going over the individual parts, we found the headspace, recoil shoulders, and chamber all to be normal.

Examination of the rifle and trigger assembly could not duplicate the incident that was described. All parts tolerances and dimensions were found to be normal, including sear-connector engagement. Also, factory seals were intact on the trigger adjustment screws, indicating no alterations were made on the trigger outside our company. Trigger pull was within our specifications at 3 1/2 pounds.

Based on our findings, Remington Arms Company, Inc., cannot accept any liability or responsibility for the incident. We can only assume that as your customer operated the bolt, he inadvertently brushed, or hit, the trigger which caused the rifle to fire.
