I was hunting in Colorado, I put a live round in the chamber when I jumped a deer. When I got back to the Blazer, I took the safety off to eject the shell. Then the gun went off - To take the shell out of the chamber the safety has to be in the off position. I feel this is a Very Dangerous situation. Not all Rem 700 are this way. Why? The barrel of the gun was resting on the floor board of the blazer, so I am worried about the headspace, and why the gun malfunctioned. This particular gun has not had more than 60 rounds fired through it. I have been more than happy with Remington until this.
