- Overall Centerfire rifle sales down approx. 20,000 over '05 (Wal-Mart 710 order expected later this month)
- 870 Express Shotguns Rebate this fall should boost sales—expected \$2M in rebates
- Current trend towards Wholesalers/Distributors not ordering inventory until
 it is absolutely needed and will sell quickly. They do not want to have the
 holding/carrying costs, this presents a challenge to manufacturing.

2006 New Products (Perniciaro/Mead/Kast)

- 750 Woodsmaster
 - Status of Writer's guns received (Towsley/Sundra)
 - Feeding concerns—rifle was dis-assembled and reassembled incorrectly, improper shoulder mount "flinching" with one writer's gun
 - Scope base hole alignment
 - Vendor issues with magazine box—working to correct this issue with vendor
- 6.8mm Rem SPC—On Hold pending testing of 105 CTi
- 1100 G3—Vendor supplying cases 2 weeks behind
- Suggested that vendor pick up shipping charges
 - o Production Status 20 GA

80 guns built for T&P

Anticipate production on 26" in July, 28" August. Orders clear by end of August.

105 CTi Update (Perniciaro, Orf, Morris, Diaz)

- Update on Current Status—Ejection issues
- Winchester "XU" shells steel heads out of

spec. (standard 0.015" – Winchester shells 0.030") causes extractor to drop the shell--EDS failure.

- Federal "Medium Brass" HT shells don't eject and are hanging causing a—DEH malfunction where spent casing head hangs on bolt stop release
- Sometimes our "light 8" loads "Don't trip bolt stop" causing a DTBS malfunction

Corrections—

- Raise height of bolt stop release from 0.700" to 0.740"—but with a 0.030" range, may only yield a 0.010" difference with current tooling.
- Modify extractor-"Under-Cut Extractor" to remedy EDS issues with the XU loads

Other Issues—

- Problem -- Fore-Ends cracking w/insert separation on some
- **Solution**—redesign venting system in fore-end—shape like vents in vent rib design
- <u>Problem</u>—Cam pin cracking when shooting magnum loads broken extrusion causes bolt to lock open
- Solution—Re-design/reinforce pin
- Problem—(4) 3" rounds fit a little tight in magazine tube
- Solution—Varying shell lengths, not a big issue

DVD Corrections—(1,000) copies

 No need to say "Remove all lubricates from gun prior to shooting" as guns will be "wiped down" with RemOil and shot 50 times prior to being packed.

Production Issues—

- 57 guns produced—30 guns in "lab"—27 in gallery test (packed) status
- On track for 130 guns to be built for June
- On track for 75 guns to be produced per day in July
- Barrel Vent Rib vendor—Issues with 50% of bbls being rejected
- Concerns over whether or not process is repeatable over a period of time

New Pump Action Shotgun (Diaz/Murphy/Perniciaro)

 Update & Review Drawing Package—about 90% complete in process of designing action bar release (new location in front of trigger guard).

- Review over molded barrel concept—Investigate Patent issues with Henry "U.S. Survival" overmolded bbls. Expect to have overmolding results by mid July.
- Review Timeline Still on track for 2007 SHOT Intro—Looking to be on track for '07 SHOT Show intro. Prototypes should be done by end of July. EET target for next 4-6 weeks.
- · Review current cost estimates

Review of cosmetic renderings with Zunda on 6/22/06 at Ilion—

- Rib on top and bottom of bbl, more masculine design concept agreed upon
- · Recoil reducing butt stock discussed
- Use the "roots" of the 870's success to tie into new pump gun, with similar receiver design.
- Camo versions, and Tactical models available in future—20 ga.?
- Offset cannibalization of 870 sales with higher margins, and reduction of SKU's in current line

Synthetic Short Stock Program (Mead)

New Autoloading Rifle (Diaz/Stone/Perniciaro)

- Current Status—E-town looking to get parts in within 2-weeks
- Evaluate Resource Allocation and Timing—may "phase-out" 7400 and 750 within next 3 years, position "New" auto as premier centerfire auto in the line

 Review design cosmetics in Ilion on 6/22/06—reviewed cosmetic renderings of "New" auto, awaiting a non-functioning prototype model.

NXS Slug System (Diaz)

SPL Conversion (Mead/Diaz)

- Status of phase in—Currently phasing in on all stainless rifles (150-200 per day)
- Review final cost impact
- Currently working with a 2 lb. pull range from 3.5 to 5.5 lbs. (previously 4.75-6.75 lbs) Trigger feels clean, breaks crisply.
- Working toward a 1 lb range—also, a black oxide model
- Box end labels will be marked with a # sign to designate new trigger guns
- Status of phase in to Model 710—\$44K tooling costs, will assemble in Mayfield
- 40-X Externally Adjustable Version—may offer in Varmint models

Model 710 Performance Improvements (Trull/Diaz/Lance/Vicars)

Now that we are on track to create a modern look for the gun with a new stock, is it possible to address other issues we experience with consumers. Issues that continue to haunt, although not on a huge scale are:

- <u>Difficult to open/close bolt</u>—Working on easier to cam bolt, Prototypes this week—reduced surface area by 10%—need to pressure test with magnum loads
- Magazine latches breaking—Current magazine latch materials change

Use of Old 710 Stock Tool for Dealer Only Gun (Lance/Trull)

- Could use old tool to create price point offering for Premier Dealer line to address competitive issues with Stevens 200 and Mossberg ATR 100
- Non-Scoped scope rail only
- Target Pricing MSP \$229-\$249
- Do we have capacity to address in addition to current production? (6k -10k units)
- Add .308 and 7mm-08 to Premier Dealer line

- Zastava reps in Mayfield, will correct some issues with fire control trigger block issues, and different (varying) length screws
