I talked with an engineer with Brainin about their quote on the safety arm. They had some recommendations on the quote that I considered with respect to the current design. The bottom line was that we were going to leave the design and the print as is. There wasn't anything there that they couldn't do it was just a little out of the recommended guidelines for a stamped part. They may have to adjust their quote a little bit based on what we talked about today. They just needed a little bit more time to consider the tool design and any necessary secondary operations. They should be sending you an updated quote shortly. If you don't get something within the next day or two you might want to give JoAnn or Dean a call to follow up.
