

VS vs. 700P

The primary difference between the 700 VS and the 700P is the reinforcement in the fore end which designed for use with a bi-pod. The 700P does go through more quality checks, since they are used as duty weapons. The 700P is the only rifle we carry with a guaranteed minute of angle, however, the 700 VS is also the most accurate out of the box production firearm available today. BREAK IN PROCEDURE –FIRE LAPPING

Clean bore with a bronze bore brush after each shot for 20 shots. Then clean every 5 shots for 20 rounds. We hope this information is helpful and we appreciate your loyal support of Remington products.

TRIGGER ADJUSTMENT

For liability reasons we do not recommend adjusting your trigger assembly. You can, however, contact one of our Authorized repair centers that could give you further information. **ADL TO BDL**

It is possible to convert your ADL Model 700 to a BDL Model 700, however; we don't recommend this type of conversion. You would have to change the magazine box, spring and follower, the trigger assembly and guard screws. These parts are approximately \$140. This price doesn't include the price of the stock. AMMONIA ETCHING BORE

Extended exposure to ammonia based products with more than 2% concentration can cause etching to the bore. Using a 50/50 mixture of alcohol and water can neutralize the ammonia. Our solvents such as Bore Bright do not contain ammonia. Thank you for your inquiry.

MOUNTAIN CONTOUR BBL

The lighter mountain rifles do have a lighter contour barrel, but they still have the same three rings of steel in the chamber area, where the combustion is contained. The weight is reduced toward the muzzle end of the barrel, therefore the thickness of the barrel is not compromised.

**5-R RIFLING**

The big advantage to 5-R rifling is that after the barrel is broken in, there is considerably less fouling of the bore and the life expectancy from an accuracy standpoint is greater. You may notice, however, that during the normal break in process there may be more metallic fouling than normal.

The rate of twist is 1:11.24" which is optimized for M118 Ball ammo as specified by the U.S.

The Model 700 SENDERO is equipped with a 26" heavy barrel that facilitates increased velocity and increased accuracy at longer ranges. The Remington model 700 is touted, in the shooting realm, as the most accurate out of the box rifle on the market today.

**A CARTRIDGE BELOW:  
LAPUA CARTRIDGE**

The model 700 magnum action has sufficient strength to withstand any of the pressures created by the Lapua cartridges, we do not recommend re-chambering a factory model 700 to the Lapua cartridge because it decreases the strength of the chamber in our barrels. You can safely re-barrel a 700 Magnum action with a barrel that is chambered for a Lapua cartridge. We hope this information is helpful and we appreciate your loyal support of Remington products.

**BOLT REPLACEMENT**

Unfortunately bolts for the Model 700's are restricted to the factory due to the fact that they have to be individually head-spaced. The charge for this service can range anywhere from \$150 to \$300 depending on how much work is involved with the individual gun.
