THE REMINGTON MODEL 700P (police) SERIES

Description

The Remington model 700P series of rifles encompasses several variants to meet the needs of law enforcement and security personnel. All of these rifles start with the Remington 700 receiver, bolt and trigger. All are placed into a aramid fiber reinforced synthetic stock that features a aluminum mounting block that runs from the forearm area into the comb to provide reliable repeatable mounting and strength. The base model in this line is the model 700P rifle which features a cold hammer forged 26" barrel. The model 700 Light Tactical rifle (LTR) features a cold hammer forged 20" fluted barrel. Both models can be had as Total Weapons Systems (TWS) which features day optics, Harris bipod and hard case. The optics on these systems are Leupold & Stevens products and are currently under revision.

These rifles are the most widely used sniper/precision systems in American law enforcement. Additionally these systems are in use by a large number of international law enforcement agencies to include Germany, UAE, Norway and England.

Remington Mark 13 Sniper Weapon System (SWS)

Description

The Remington Mark 13 Sniper Weapon System was developed by US Special Operations Forces to provide a medium to long range sniper system to be used against personnel and lightly skinned material targets and is chambered in 300 Winchester Magnum. This system is custom built using a variety of custom components to include a Remington 700 long action, bolt, trigger, Modular Accessory Rail (MARS), a match barrel, Badger Ordnance 30mm rings, Leupold 4.5-15X Mark IV M1 day optic, Harris bipod and Accuracy International Stock.

This system has seen wide spread use by many components and has been credited with engagements over 800 meters. It is unknown how many systems are currently in use but it appears that at least 100 have been built.
