

MODEL 700 CHANGES FROM INTRODUCTION

- 1962 Model 700 introduced in ADL and BDL versions with bolt lock feature
- 1963 Added 6 MM Rem caliber to each
- 1964 Added 700 D grade and 700 F grade (Extra fancy wood and engraving) to the BDL
- 1965 New finish on the e ADL and BDL
- 1966 Offered 22 inch bbl, detachable sights, and added Varmint caliber (22-250 Rem)
- 1967 Introduced the M/700 Varmint Special - Chambered in 5 Varmint calibers with a Heavy target barrel
- 1968
- 1969 Introduced the M/700 Custom - American walnut stock, hand checkering, and highly polished, with or without sights
- 1970 Added 25.06 Rem caliber
- 1971 Added 17 Rem caliber
- 1972
- 1973 Introduced left-hand BDL available in 3 calibers
- 1974 Redesigned fore-end and grip for left-hand models. Restyled cosmetics on all versions - Stainless steel magazine follower, introduction of the anti-bind bolt design, redesigned bolt Handle, and new rear sight.

- 1976 Added calibers to the Varmint Special.

- 1978 Introduced the Classic line.

**MODEL 700 CHANGES FROM INTRODUCTION**

- 1982 Added calibers, and stopped putting on the bolt lock feature.
- 1983 Restyled ADL -- slimmer grip, restyled fore-end, and new pattern cut checkering, and satin wood finish. Introduced the Model Seven in 5 short action calibers.
- 1984 Added calibers
- 1985 Added calibers
- 1986 Introduced the Mountain Rifle - tapered barrel, cut checkering, slender cheek piece, 1/2 Pound lighter than standard M/700, and available in 3 calibers.
- 1987 Introduced synthetic stock versions M/700 RS (Rynite stock) and M/700 FS (Fiberglass stock)
- 1988 Introduction of laminated stocks. Introduction of the M/700 KS (Kevlar stock) and M/700 Safari grade and 700 Grade II (hand rubbed English walnut) all available from the Custom Shop by special order. Added classic caliber.
- 1989 Added calibers
- 1990 Introduced the M/700 AS - synthetic stock and glare reducing matte finish.
- 1991 Added calibers
- 1992 Introduced M/700 Varmint Synthetic, M/700 Stainless Synthetic, and left-hand versions of The Safari rifle and the Kevlar stocked Mountain Rifle. Added caliber to the Mountain Rifle. Introduced the M/700 Synthetic Camo. Added classic caliber
- 1993 Introduced M/700 European - hand rubbed oil finish favored by European sportsmen. Introduced M/700 BDL Stainless Synthetic and M/700 Mountain Rifle Stainless Synthetic.
- 1994 Added calibers. Introduced 700 Sendero and 700 VS SF.
- 1995 Introduced Detachable Magazines in BDL, BDL SS, and Mountain Rifle. Introduced 700 BDL VLS -- varmint rifle with laminated stock. Added various calibers.
- 1996 Introduced 700 ML and MLS black powder rifles featuring the in-line design. Introduced the 700 ADL Synthetic. Changed the BDL engraving to Fine-line Engraving. Introduced the 700 LSS. Offered a stainless muzzle brake.
- 1997 Offered the 700 ML and MLS in Mossy-Oak camo. Added various calibers. Changed the Engraving on the 700 BDL SS DM. Introduced the 700 ML/MLS Custom -- Assembled in The Custom Shop with a custom thumb hole stock.

# MODEL 700 CHANGES FROM INTRODUCTION

- 1998 Introduced the 700 ML Youth and the 700 ADL Synthetic Youth rifle. Introduced a new Stock for the 700 VLS. Offered muzzle porting for the 700 VS-SF. Introduced the 700 LSS and VS LH rifles. Added various calibers.
- 1999 Introduced the 300 Remington Ultra Magnum in 700 BDL, BDL SS, and Sendero rifles. Introduced the composite barrel. Added various calibers.
- 2000 Introduced the 700 EtronX™. Added 338 Ultra Magnum to various rifles.
- 2001 Introduced the 700 Titanium. The Model 710 BA rifle was introduced, produced in Mayfield, KY.
- 2002 Introduced the Model Seven Magnum line.
- 2003 Introduced the Model 673 Guide Rifle base on the Model 600 design.
- 2004 Introduced the Model 700 CDL classic deluxe; available in 8 calibers. Introduced the Model 700 LV SF light varmint rifle. Added magnum calibers to the Model 710.
- 2005 Introduced the Model 700 XCR extreme conditions rifle, the Model XR-100 competition Grade rifle, and the Model 700 SPS special purpose synthetic rifle. Added a steel receiver Insert to the Model 710 rifle.
- 2006 Added a stainless fluted rifle to the Model 700 CDL line. Introduced the Model Seven CDL Line.
- 2007 Added a limited edition model to the Model 700 CDL line. Introduced the Model 770. Added additional camo offerings in most Model 700 rifles. Made thumbhole stocks available for some Model 700 rifles.
