Students will disassemble and reassemble the Firing pin assembly, the extractor, and the ejector. Practice bolt assemblies will be provided by the instructor for use during the class.

Initial inspection, Safety concerns, Checks and trouble shooting, Repair Procedures and Adjustments, Older and newer style parts, service checks, Maintenance of firearm and cleaning procedures, Barrel stampings and Serial Number structure, "Hands On" disassembly and reassembly of firearms and major components of the student's M/700 firearms. Discussion of types of scope mounts available, breaking-in procedures, the differences between Police and civilian rifles, and types of trigger systems available.

Each student will be given the opportunity to remove and reinstall the trigger assembly of the M/700 rifle utilizing slave training receivers provided by the instructor.

At the completion of the M/700 segment we will have a written examination.

The pace of the class will be adjusted to meet the requirements of the students attending.
