Initially I would highly recommend some action be taken on the rifle to get it back to safe working order, but
after the rifle has been rectified then any available load for the 7mm Ultra Mag would be more than sufficient
for any bull elk you could ever hope to encounter. The Core-Lokt Ultra Bonded and Swift Scirocco load we offer
are specifically designed for just this kind of heavy skin, and large boned animal and should perform flawlessly
and give you effective killing power out to a range of about 600 yards where it is still delivering
approximately 1500 ft/lbs of energy.

The serial number is S6393408. The gun is not safe.The gun has fired more than
once when he starts to push the safety off.His finger has not been on the trigger.

He has had the gun worked on by a gunsmith. The gun still fires without pulling the
trigger.I think know it is with the safety off(not sure about safety) I do know if the butt of the gun is
bumped against a hard surface you can hear the trigger click.

My brother has had the gun for a good while,but because he feels it is unsafe and
has lost confidence in the rifle lets it remain in his vault. I know have the Rifle,what can I

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do to correct the problem.

I started to take the rifle to a gunsmith, decided not to because he has already spent a great deal of money on the rifle and the problem is not corrected. Please inform me of my options.
