**2008 Spring/Seasonal Products Overview**

The 2008 Spring/Seasonal Products line will consist of a large menagerie of products from both the shotgun and rifle lines that are geared towards the “seasonal” categories typically consisting of Turkey hunting, Varmint/Predator hunting, and all aspects of the Target shooting sports (both Shotgun and Rifle). These products are seasonal in nature in that the bulk of orders will occur from August thru November and sell through will occur from January through April/May in any given year. Knowing this, it makes sense to gear factory production of these firearms to the time of year where these said firearms would be ready for warehouse position during the final quarter of the year before the spring program is to begin. For instance, in order to be prepared for Spring 2008 orders, production of all SKU’s on the spring program (ideally) should begin in October 2007 and run through January 2008—with the ultimate plan to produce those items within that window only, and not resume production until the following Spring program time span for 2009.

From my end, I plan to have the following year’s Spring program finalized—from a new product addition and deletion perspective—done by mid April of the previous year (Ex. April 2007 for the Spring 2008 product line). As a part of this process, I will communicate these additions/deletions to the appropriate persons via a listing of all proposed deletions, and a posting of all New Product Proposals (NPPs) during this time span. This will give production time to begin gearing up for the new products, as well as giving them time to scale back current production of products that are slated to be deleted from the product line.

2008 Spring Program Additions

The Model 11-87 Sportsman S-MAG Thumbhole Turkey Camo is meant to replace the current model with the Boyd's Laminated TH-Stock. With the new Ambidextrous Synthetic TH-Stock, this model will achieve two-fold benefits in that it will be cheaper to produce (by about \$70 per unit), and it will serve a market where both Left and Right Handed shooters can use one gun. This gun will be an addition to the current 11-87 Sportsman line of shotguns as we implement a plan to phase out the current 11-87 SPS line of shotguns. Features will include:

**2008 Full Line Shotguns Overview**

Two unique changes are on tap for the 2008 Full line of Shotguns. First we have the all new Model 887 "Overmold" Super Magnum pump shotgun. Representing the future in Remington pump shotgun technology, the Model 887 is totally encased in a space-age polymer to help resist rust and corrosion, and make for a very unique and "Techy" looking pump shotgun. Based upon the successes of the Model 870 Express Super Magnum shotguns, the new Model 887 will take the place of the current line of Model 870 Express Super Magnum shotguns.

The introductory offering will consist of a family of 4 guns which will include the following: 12/28" and a 12/26" black guns, a 12/22" Full Camo Turkey Model, and a 12/28" Full Camo Waterfowl Model.

The 11-87 Shotgun family will be re-organized in the following manner: All of the current Model 11-87 SPS shotguns will be phased out, and four similar models will be rolled-over into the Model 11-87 Sportsman line of shotguns. Among these will be a Waterfowl model, a full camo Thumbhole Turkey Model, an all black synthetic model, and a camo stock and fore-end Fully Rifled Cantilever model. In order to capitalize on the successes of the 11-87 Sportsman line, we will introduce the 11-87 Super Magnum models and benefit two-fold: enjoy higher margins on the Super Magnum guns, and increase sales volume in the category, while at the same time, offering comparable firearms (that were available in the 11-87 SPS Line) at a more economical price point to help drive sales. Also, all current Model 11-87 shotguns with synthetic short stocks will be converted to the NEW synthetic short stock design.

The 1100 G3 family of shotguns will expand with a 12/28" Left hand version to offer a firearm to the left hand shooters (filling a gap that has been present since the deletion of the Left hand 11-87 Premier).

The 870 Express Magnum line will essentially stay the same with a few minor changes and deletions, the most notable change of which will incorporate a NEW synthetic short stock design on all currently produced synthetic stocked models.

The final major change for the entire shotgun line is the NEW R3 "SuperCell" pad which will be added to most new shotgun products, and all of our shotguns currently using the R3 recoil pad. The gist of this new pad is described in the following paragraphs:

Below the surface, we've been working even harder with the incorporation of literally millions of tiny "SuperCells" of varying size and shape that work together to diminish recoil with an instantaneous compression of these "SuperCells" in the areas where it counts most, to help you concentrate on the intended target, and remain on target for ultra-quick follow up shots.
