S. M. Alvis reviewed the information presented in his memorandum of December 30, 1955, copy of which is attached (pp. 11-15). This showed an excellent malfunction rate for the first guns tested. It was emphasized that this was a prepilot test of guns put up by Research and Development. The Plant is now putting up some guns which, however, have several parts produced in the model shop. The first guns assembled with regularly manufactured parts will be available in about a week, and a routine nilot test will then be undertaken. pilot test will then be undertaken.
