#### SPORTSMAN-58

The questions on quality raised at the last meeting were discussed by the Plant and Research and Development. These included the following:

Locking block notch upset. It is true that occasionally a gun will be found in which the block will score the receiver rearward of the notch before the block falls into place. However, this situation is no different than that found in the Model 11-48 or in the Model 870. Experience with these guns over a period of several years leads to assurance that this is not a serious problem and causes no harm.

Fit between fore-end and receiver. As they promised at the last meeting, the Plant has watched this carefully and report that there is no problem of fit.
