Match Rifle

The Sales Department has furnished to Ilion Research and Development specifications for a match rifle in 308 and 30/06 calibers. They estimate that sales might amount to from 200 to 300 guns per year.

Ilion Research and Development has, with the concurrence of the Ilion Plant, written to the Director of Research and Development explaining that they believe the meeting of specifications such as those established by Sales requires a job shop operation for which the Ilion Plant is not at the present time equipped. It is believed that, if the production of first-quality match rifles by Remington is justified by its advertising advantage, Management should authorize the establishment of a separate match rifle shop.

Rear Sight

In accordance with a request from Dewey Godfrey, the possibility of applying Lyman or Marble rear sights has been investigated, and the Ilion Plant reported that an increase in factory cost of \$1.07 for the Lyman sight or \$1.21 for the Marble sight would be involved.
