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TEST NO. 2 (FUNCTIONAL TESTING)
POWER CONE VS. DIAL-A-MATIC ON SPORTSMAN-58 GUNS.

- A. Performance of current Sportsman-58 (with Dial-a-matic, carrier latch and magazine flipper) on Winchester magnum loads with 30" full choke barrel and Winchester trap loads with 26" barrel.
- B. Same gun and ammunition as above but with Power Cone substituted for Dial-a-matic cap.
- C. Same gun and ammunition as B with Power Cone and with magazine flipper removed.

Results.

First two guns, selected from regular production, would not perform satisfactorily, particularly on Winchester magnum loads. 83

Gun No. 2202 was then selected for test. This gun was an original Sales Representative model with a record of zero malfunctions in 325 rounds. Test results on this gun were as follows:
