## ORDER

THIS MATTER coming to be heard for pretrial and on plaintiffs motion to compel and for sanctions, due notice having been given and the court having heard oral argument:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Remington shall respond to plaintiffs' supplemental interrogatories on or before September 15, 1987;
2. Remington will produce at its expense employees and former employees Beneth and Workman for further questioning on documents produced subsequent to their depositions; on or before October 15, 1987;
3. Attorney fees are granted to plaintiffs' counsel for time spent from the time of preparation of this motion to the hearing on this motion and costs to be presented to this court at a later date after submitting it to Remington's counsel;
4. With respect to plaintiffs' request to provide the finder with the facts surrounding Remington's production of documents, that request is denied without prejudice and will be left to the discretion of the trial judge.
5. Pretrial in this matter is continued to November 16, 1987 at 3:30 p.m. without further notice.
