Sec. And Sec. During assembly of pilot guns, some difficulty in feeding was experienced. It is now believed that this has been overcome, and assembly is continuing. Twenty guns were released for Sales field test on December 4 and 5, and it is expected that ten guns will be selected for formal pilot test by December 14.

Sales field tests are not completed. In tests to date, performance of the guns has been generally satisfactory. In 200 rounds fired, there were five incidents of fired cases caught between the barrel and the bolt as it closed. Most of these hap-pened on the last shot, and they are believed by the designers to occur because there is no incoming cartridge on the ramp to help guide the fired case through the ejection port. This is not con-sidered a serious deficiency.\*
