Common Sight Line Stock

Through a misunderstanding, it was reported in the minutes of the last meeting that at the time of adoption of the common sight line stock it was desired to introduce a hooded front sight in Models 721 and 722. Recognizing that this would introduce serious problems in production and would increase costs substantially, Sales is not requesting that this change be made. To prevent further misunderstanding, the Ilion Plant prepared a chart (attached) showing the main features of the proposed versions of the Models 740-760, Models 721-722, and Model 725. The committee agreed that the Plant should go ahead with the project on the basis of this program.

As promised at the last meeting, Sales submitted the following forecast. (See note below.)
