MODEL 870

28 and 410 Gauges

S. M. Alvis reported that Research and Development has reached the model-making stage. According to present plans, the same receiver will be used for the 28 and the 410, and the same magazine tube with an insert to reduce 28 gauge to 410. In order to use the same fore-end on both guns, the 410 gauge barrel will be heavier than usual. The Sales Department was requested to consider whether this might not be a desirable feature since it will prevent the 410 gauge from being muzzle-light.
