SHOTGUNS

MODEL 870

28 and 410 Gauges

The Model 870 28 gauge has been shown to Sales and returned to Research and Development for some suggested appearance modifications. Similar modifications will be made in the 410 gauge gun now being produced.

As was noted in the minutes of the last meeting, the latest economic review showed that introduction of the 28 and 410 gauges in the Model 870 was not justified. Plan 3 was therefore proposed for adoption. This anticipates deletion of the 28 and 410 gauges in the Model 11-48 and introduction in the Sportsman-58. Because of the success of the Sportsman-58 without any A grade gun, it has been suggested that the 28 and 410 gauges should be available only in the ADL Grade and higher. The changes referred to in the first paragraph are in this direction.
