At your request ten of the above guns were withdrawn from warehouse on 12-1-57 and subjected to test on that date.

Conclusion

Function-wise, these rifles performed satisfactorily. Two of the rifles had sticky unlocking but could be opened without too much difficulty. Otherwise there were no other malfunctions. All ten guns unloaded live ammunition satisfactorily.

Endurance testing showed broken rear sights on three rifles. This has been reported and followed through by the Audit Group.

Procedure

All ten rifles were fired a total of 320 rds. using the 125, 150 and the 165 gr. bullets. The first 120 rds. were fired in the field using four shooters and the remainder fired in the shooting racks.
