MODEL 878 "AUTOMASTER"

The Committee understands that model number and name have been approved.

A sample gun, not a production model but incorporating a production receiver and representing an exact appearance sample, has been delivered to G. M. Calhoun for Management inspection. A competitive gun (J. C. Higgins Model 66) for comparison purposes is on order.

Pilot assembly of approximately seventy 12 gauge guns has been started. Serial numbers start at 1001. Assuming satisfactory pilot testing, these production guns should be available for field test and other purposes the middle of November.
