MODEL 870 RIOT GUN - FORE-END

a she In a letter from S. M. Alvis to the Secretary dated January 8, 1959, copies of which were supplied to Committee January 8, 1959, copies of which were supplied to Committee members, it was pointed out that the new style fore-end presently supplied with riot guns was not dimensionally compatible with special gun locking devices used in law enforcement rehicles. The letter states the Plant's proposal to supply riot guns with shortened new style fore-ends to remedy the difficulty.

A sample rict gun with shortened fore-and was shown to the Committee, along with sample vehicle gun locking devices.

Economics based on shortening of fore-ends in process, without obsolescence, were presented by the Plant. Additional cost of the shortened fore-end per gun is estimated at \$.13, and expenditure for tooling and engineering is set at \$130.

The Plant reported that 400 to 500 rict guns are in stock and fuestioned whether modifications were to include these guns. The Sales Department recommended that no alterations be made to fore-ends to guns in warehouse stock but that shortened foreends should be provided on all new riot guns, without obsolescence. The Sales-Order Department will assume the responsibility of phasing out longer fore-end guns now in the warehouse to agencies where vehicle locking devices are not used.
