## XC-6 (AUTOLOADER)

The status of this development parallels that of the XS-6 shotgun, described in these minutes.

Research & Development reports that the XC-6 rifle will meet or exceed the current Model 721 in structural strength.

The design is such that the basic 30-06 caliber model can be modified to handle Magnum calibers, with some increase in action size and bulk, if the Sales Department desires Magnum models.

Research & Development expects an XC-6 appearance model from the model shop by July 1, 1959. Drawings of the XC-6 will be shown in a Bridgeport meeting with the Sales Department scheduled for the first week in June.

(Subsequent to the meeting, it was determined that the Bridgeport meeting would be held on June 4, 1959.)
