The Research & Development Department reports that model making is continuing on this item. A shooting model is scheduled for January 1960. Initial test models will not incorporate the nylon stock proposed for the production model.

Proceedings of the Bridgeport Division Operations Committee relative to a new 255 caliber Remington cartridge were reported, in view of the proposed adaptation of the XC-6 rifle to this cartridge. The Research & Development Department reported that characteristics of the 255 Remington cartridge have been communicated to them by or the 200 Remington cartridge have been communicated to them by Bridgeport. It was further reported that the proposed 255 Remington cartridge appears feasible for use in the XC-6 action provided that dimensions of the cartridge do not exceed the 30/06 in diameter. The matter of feeding and extracting the belted case proposed for the new cartridge may cause problems. Ilion Research & Development Department will collaborate closely with Bridgeport and periodic reports of progress will be made to the Committee.
