NYLON STOCKED BOLT ACTION RIFLES - N-11 and N-12

The Production Department reports that revised bolt handles have not yet been received from the vendor. However, warehouse quantities are expected to be on hand by January 1, 1962.

Current scheduling calls for providing a nylon stocked version of the Model 510 at and year 1962. Present Model 510 rifles will be produced in sufficient quantities to carry over until the N-10 model is available.

Research & Development reports that work has been discontinued on a hylon stocked version of the Model 514.

NYLON 76 LEVER ACTION RIFLES

This item is currently moving into production. Latest schedule calls for warehouse quantities on March 1, 1962.

CHROME AND BLACK NYLON 66

This item comprises the Nylon 66 rifle mechanism provided with a black nylon stock and a chrome plated barrel and receiver cover.

Cost comparisons indicate an additional factory cost of \$1.11 per gun for the chrome and black version. Estimated full factory cost for the regular Nylon 66 and this item are as follows:
