

Model Guns - Original scheduling called for completion of 25 model guns by February 1, 1962. Changes in design will delay completion of these guns. The Sales Department feels that model guns should be made available as soon as possible, even though latest design changes are not incorporated therein. As improvements are added, additional testing will be made.

MODEL 370 - 28 and 410 GAUGE CONVERSIONS

Research & Development reports that further work on adopting the Simmons conversion was deferred on the basis of a Sales Department indication that magazine capacity of two shells was insufficient. Further, design concentration on the Sportsman 68 made extensive work on these items impractical.
