NYLON 10 SINGLE SHOT RIFLE

The Nylon TO is in production. Approximately 200 were warehoused in May and the schedule for June is 100 a day.

The Sales Department stated that the Nylon 10 will be announced during June.

General Management approved on May 23, 1962 the Committee's recommendation to discontinue the Models 510, 511, and 512.

XR-6 M-14 (N-66) TRAINING RIFLE

The Research and Development Department exhibited a sample M-l4 training rifle. The objective of this development is to externally duplicate the M-l4 military rifle for low cost training with rim fire ammunition. The exterior appearance of the sample was the same as the M-l4. The action of a production rifle which would be that of the Nylon 66. For purposes of the sample, its stack encased a complete Nylon 66 capable of demonstration shooting.

The model is available for Government Sales to discuss with interested agencies and determine the future course of this development.

MODEL 572 LIGHTWEIGHT

The Model 572 Lightweight was discontinued January 11, 1962 per Informative Bulletin #2-1962. Among the reasons for discontinuing the model was the possible patent infringement of the composite steel and aluminum parrel. In process barrels and barrel material were held at their various stages of manufacture.

Subscripently, an unlimited license to manufacture lightweight barrels has been obtained. The balance of lightweight barrels and barrel materials on hand will be completed and assembled as Model 572A.
