

RIM FIRE RIFLES

The postponing of the introduction of a Bolt Action Rim Fire rifle until January 1967 raised the question of what Remington will have to offer as "new" for 1966.

In the discussion, a review was made of the past programs to "dress up" the Bolt Action guns and the change from a wood to nylon Stock and re-introduction of wood.

The Rim Fire Committee had completed the study and had recommended that R & D undertake a redesign of the Rim Fire line starting with the Bolt Action guns.


Committee Action
