

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 870 TB AND TC - MODEL 1100 TB MONTE CARLO STOCK - contd.Committee Action

Based on the economics, the committee approved and recommends General Management approve the addition of a Monte Carlo Stock for Model 870 TB and TC and Model 1100 TB grade guns as optional.

MODEL 1100, 28 & 410 GAUGE CONVERSION

At Sales request, R & D considered the conversion of 20 gauge Model 1100 guns to 28 gauge. This is a design similar to that being offered by Simmons. It was Sales opinion that both a 28 and 410 gauge conversion should be offered. It was pointed out by R & D that even with the conversion to the 28 gauge, some functioning difficulties occur and a significant design change would be required for the 410 gauge.

Committee Action

R & D is to prepare a letter listing the high spot economics, development costs and time for further consideration of this proposed program.

MODEL 32 OVER AND UNDER SHOTGUN

Remington furnished drawings of the Model 32 Over and Under 12 gauge single trigger shotgun to the Combined Service Forces, Republic of China (Taiwan) for estimates to manufacture. It would be necessary for the Stock and Fore End to be made in the United States. This would also require fitting of the related metal parts.

As an alternate, the Ilion plant has been requested to review and prepare estimated costs to produce the Model 32 at the Ilion plant, based on the original model drawings. Modern manufacturing processes such as precision castings are being used due to the projected low volume.
