

FIREARMSSHOTGUNSMODEL 1100 AUTOLOADING SHOTGUNMahogany Stock & Fore Ends - 20 Gauge

Production reported that dried mahogany plank was scheduled for delivery to Ilion the first part of May. Assembly of approximately fifteen hundred (1500) 20 gauge shotguns with the mahogany Stocks and Fore Ends would start in July.

At the February meeting, Marketing had indicated shipments would be made at random to all regions. Further review now indicated the advisability of controlling distribution. Shipments will be to the Southern and Southwestern Regions.

Committee Action

The Ilion plant was requested to complete gun assembly as promptly as possible. Marketing's recommendation to control shipments was considered to be the better program.

28-410 Gauge Conversion

A security agreement which was approved by General Management was sent to Simmons for approval. This, when signed, will provide a working basis for a coordinated program with Simmons to offer a 28 and 410 gauge conversion. The objective is to improve performance of guns to be marketed by Simmons. Remington would profit by part sales and the advertising resulting from the Simmons conversion of the Model 1100 shotgun.

Further action is held until the agreement has been signed by Simmons. After approval, the Ilion R & D will take over responsibility of working out the future program with Simmons.
