The Ilion plant is to review the standard machine requirements and delivery dates. Action is to be taken to obtain advance authorization where a delay in immediately placing orders could result in a delay to the program.

NOTE: A review was made of the prototype rifle by representatives of Marketing following the Operations Committee meeting. In addition to the suggestions made at the meeting, the general configuration was reviewed and compared with the Browning rifle and other Remington rifles. R & D is to prepare a revised prototype in which the Fore End is to be reduced in length and size as soon as possible. A further review is to be made with Marketing.

XR-XC SERIES BOLT ACTION LINE

R & D reviewed the single shot, clip magazine, tubular and single shot magnum model Bolt Action Rim Fire Rifles. Models of the 22 and 30-30 caliber Center Fire Rifles were also displayed. The proposed expansion of the line to replace the Model 513T and 521T target rifles was outlined by R & D. The economics and proposed project presentation do not include funds for any target version.

Remington's ammunition program has abandoned the production of the Winchester 22 magnum cartridge. The possibility of Remington developing a magnum cartridge was discussed. The rim fire rifle as designed has limitations on the handling of any longer or greater diameter cartridge.
