XR-XC SERIES BOLT ACTION LINE - contd.

A similar review was made of the XR Center Fire Rifle features. The presentation covered the reason for the rear lockup required to feed rimmed cartridges. The action is adequate to handle cartridges having strength requirements through the 308 caliber.

The cartridges now proposed for initial introduction have been revised to the 222 Remington, 22-250 Remington, 3Q-30 Winchester and 44 Remington Magnum.

Marketing indicated that the sales volumes as shown in the project are attainable.

Bridgeport and Ilion R & D are to review the possibility of developing a magnum cartridge that can be accommodated in the XR Rim Fire Rifle design.

Marketing is establishing model designation for the proposed XR-XC Bolt Action Rifles.

Committee Action

The project is to be revised to expand on the features which warrant the introduction of the new rifles. The project is to be submitted for the Board of Director's consideration at the April 15 meeting:

A model min fire and center fire rifle, and all competitive samples are to be retained in Bridgeport for the present.

HAND GUNS

ALP 22 CALIBER PISTOL
