## CDC - SINGLE PARREL SECTION

The cutaway appearance sample submitted is indeed a good looking gun in comparison to those marketed by our competitors. It is assumed CBC production guns (less flash chrome receiver) will match sample.

The Export Department indicates the U.S. Customs might question our cost of \$9.90 if competition so desires to challenge camo. The basis being, if the cost was 10¢ more per gun, or \$10.00 - then the duty would be \$3.50 or \$1.02 additional. By adding \$1.02 to our cast, the operative return would be unattractive.

The gus as received from CMC we are told would be packaged in plain boxes and identified with end labels. In addition, all guns would be proof-tested by CBC to American standards.

Also, necessary warranty work would be charged back to CBC.

Guns should bear serial numbers and if barrels are not interchangeable then matching numbers should appear on both the receiver and barrel. In addition, it might be necessary to indicate the gun was made in Brazil for
