MODEL 742-760 "BDL" GRADE

Stocks with the cheek piece for left hand shooters are at the copy lathe operation. Pilot Stocks should be completed in September.

The Model 742 "BDL" rifle shown at the July meeting and a rifle with improved metal and wood finishes was reviewed. Marketing had indicated prior to the meeting that the added cost for the wood finish was not justified.

Table 6 shows the added direct labor costs by component; Table 7 the effect on the Model 742 and 760 factory cost, and the cash cost data to produce the improved finish. Equipment for finishing would be required.

Marketing indicated that neither the selling price for the fore-cast volume could be increased with the improved finish desired for the "BDL" grade rifles. There was a discussion of the metal finish for all center fire rifles and shotguns. An item of metal finishes will be added to the agenda and is reported on page 8 of this Operations Committee Minutes.
