

CENTER FIRE RIFLES - contd.MODEL 742-760 "BDL" GRADE - contd.Committee Action

The Model 760 and 742 Center Fire Rifles will be introduced in 1966 with the present metal and RK-W finishes. Improvement in metal finishes will be part of the proposed overall improvement being considered for shotguns and center fire rifles.

The announcement January 1966 of the "BDL" rifles in the calibers listed was approved.

MODEL 700 BOLT ACTION CENTER FIRE RIFLEFloor Plate & Trigger Guard "BDL" Grade

As a result of field requests, Marketing had recommended that the finish of the Floor Plate and Trigger Guard for the "BDL" be changed from a dull blast to a bright finish.

Committee Action

The changeover to the bright finish would be part of the improved finishes program for center fire and shotgun metal components.

MODEL 600 MAGNUM BOLT ACTION RIFLECaliber 6.5mm Remington

Production reported that pilot operations are scheduled to start in October with assembly starting in November.

Marketing requested that rifles and ammunition be available to ship for field testing not later than November.
