MODEL 700-600 BARRELED ACTION

During 1965, Model 700 "ADL, "BDL", and Model 600 Barreled Actions were offered to selected gunsmiths. Sales were estimated at seven hundred (700) units. Actual sales were six hundred and seventytwo (672) plus twenty-four (24) Model 40X target rifle Barreled Actions.

A comparison of the estimated and actual economics is shown as Table 1.

MODEL 760 SLIDE ACTION CENTER FIRE RIFLE,

Informative Bulletin No. 8-59, October 29, 1959, authorized the discontinuance of manufacture of the Model 760 A and "ADL" in the 222 caliber.

Export sales has previously received orders for Model 760. 222 caliber rifles. An order for approximately two hundred (200) rifles has been received for delivery in March. The rifle has been used primarily in international competition for "running deer" events.

The Committee approved the manufacture of Model 760, 222 caliber rifles for export sales.

Production to warehouse to date is five hundred and twentyfour (524) rifles.
