LOAD SEPARATION - SHOT SHELLS

J. D. McEachern, in a Letter to W. H. Carter on New York 9, 1965, states that he and others had difficulty in separating shot shell loads as to shot size. He suggests a much larger interval for shot-size, even at the expense of increasing the brand name.

Presently shot shell loads carry two, three or four fine pointing which necessarily limits the fine and accuracy of the point. The limit would like to be resultant to the Operations Committee has proposed on December 4, 1964 - "Body Pointing Specification," which we believe will eliminate this problem and, in addition, have the advantages stated on accompanying chart.

If this is too far out, acceptable to Sales we propose that certain shot shell loads be selected for testing period.
