R & D proposed that with the number of center fire bolt action rifles now being offered by Remington, the addition of the Mannlicher Stock might not be advisable at the present time.

Marketing requested cost comparisons of the Model 700 and 600 models for review at the February meeting. A decision can then be made on the future program.

MODEL 40XC TARGET RIFLE

A review was made of the proposed Stock and Rail change at Fort Benning. It appears that one design would not satisfy everyone. R & D now proposes to continue the model 40XB and provide a replacement for the International Match Stock which can also use the Model 40X action.

R & D is to make a prototype rifte incorporating as many of the recommendations as possible from the government source reviews.
