Marketing is to determine the information required for the proposed retention of the Model 11-48 as proposed. In the consideration, the marketing of only one model under a brand name should be assumed.

MODEL 1100 AUTOLOADING SHOTGUNFore End

There are two problems in adding the fiberglass insert to the Fore End. The first is the adequate adhesion of the fiberglass to the wood. R & D and Process Engineering are working on this problem.

The second is the milling of the rear end and the Receiver clearance. As the part is presently milled on one side, the fiberglass is loosened even though the bond appears adequate. Other methods of milling are being investigated.

The problems must be overcome before production can be started.

MODEL 879, 12 GA. AUTOLOADING SHOTGUN  
(MODEL 600A ERI MONTGOMERY WARD & CO.)

Management approved the contract to furnish Montgomery Ward & Co. with a brand name autoloading 12 gauge shotgun. Details of handling of repairs remain to be finalized.

Production of the major components is progressing.

Delays have been encountered in the fabrication of the Fore End and the equipment for the variable pressure required by the checkering pattern.
