The marking of the "F" and "S" on the Receiver for the Model 660 and 700 was approved. The marking is to be as visible as the design will permit.

R & D is to release the marking drawings to the plant.

MODEL 660 CARBINE BOLT ACTION RIFLE

An appearance sample Model 660 rifle was shown to the Committee.

Production reported that fifty (50) rifles will be assembled the first part of June. Ten (10) rifles should be shipped to the field for testing by June 15.
