

SHOTGUNS (cont'd)MODEL 1100 AUTOLOADING SHOTGUNFore End

Thirty-five (35) Fore Ends with the fiberglass reinforcement were completed and checked for cracks using fluorescent dye and inspected under black light. Only one Fore End had cracks and were due to natural wood faults and not processing.

Two test shipments of guns have been made and will be returned for analysis.

Tooling to produce one-thousand (1000) Fore Ends should be ready for production by June 19.

MODEL 878 - 12 GAUGE AUTOLOADING SHOTGUN

Based on the economics (Exhibit 3) Management approved the furnishing of five-hundred (500) Model 878 - 12 gauge shotguns to Canada. Delivery is scheduled to start in August and be completed in September.

Committee Action:

The Ilion Plant is to furnish the guns as scheduled. This item will be dropped.

SHOTGUN RECOIL PAD

The dies to produce the Recoil Pad are in the Firestone Plant. As soon as the rubber worker's strike is settled, a date for samples will be established.

Since a second set of dies will be required to meet 1968 production schedules, Purchasing is requesting quotations from other sources.
