

TRAPS - contd.TOURNAMENT TRAPS

The air efficiency of the prototype pneumatic trap has been improved; however, more targets are being broken. The equipment will now handle the Remington product. This is a hand-fed version. Another demonstration with Marketing personnel is planned in the near future.

The "Nimrod" trap received from Germany was not auto-angling and is hand fed. The vendor does not make an auto-angling trap. R & D plans to review with Marketing the advisability of purchasing additional "Nimrod" traps and make a setup at Lordship for test purposes.

METAL FINISHES

The installation of the equipment for improved finishing of Barrels and Receivers is complete. In production operation, more fixtures than anticipated are required. Orders have been placed and the full complement should be available the first part of 1968. As a result, some added buffing operations for Barrel Assemblies have been required to provide a comparable finish. The change to the improved finish for the Model 700 will be delayed until 1968.

As a result of problems in getting into full production on the Barrels and Receivers, development of fixtures and procurement will extend the program on the miscellaneous small components into 1968.
