FIBERGLASS LINED MODEL 1100 FORE ENDS

As per your letter of September 18, 1967, the six redesigned fore ends with the fiberglass liner were installed on September 22, 1967 on six Model 1100 guns used in our ballistics tests.

The following interim report lists the guns and rounds fired to date.
